911 Rate Increase

The State of South Dakota increased the 911 emergency services surcharge from \$1.25 to \$2.00 during the 2024 legislative session, making this amount effective increased 7/1/24 through 7/1/26. Proceeds from the 911 surcharge imposed all "service users" telecommunications service. wireless telecommunications service, or Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services are to be used for the funding of allowable nonrecurring recurring costs of 911 systems across the State. Pursuant to South Dakota Codified Laws § 34-45-4 voice service providers are required to collect and remit the 911 emergency surcharges to the SD Department of Revenue and to state such charges in any billing statement, invoice, or receipt.
